Dear Patient,

We are looking forward to seeing you soon for your implant placement procedure.

This is just a note to explain what will happen on the day and try to allay any fears you may have. On the day before we would ask you refrain from alcohol as this can interact with the sedative agent we plan to use. In addition, we would ask you rinse twice daily with Corsodyl mouthwash the day before and on the day. If you do not have any, please call in for a complementary bottle; the reception staff will expect you.

On the day please eat normally but again refrain from alcohol. There is no need to starve yourself as with a General anaesthetic. Your escort, whom we would ask to remain at the practice during the surgery, will of course, accompany you. May we suggest they bring some reading material!

When you enter the surgery, you will notice a few changes. Please, do not be alarmed!

We use sterile drapes on the work surfaces and some will be placed on you. In addition, the surgery staff will be wearing surgical gowns. All this is to minimise any chance of infection. There may also be more people in the surgery than normal. This is usual practice in an operating theatre as some of us will be sterile and some not.

We may ask you to take some antibiotics and analgesics pre-operatively.

After the procedure we would ask you go home and rest.

Do not drive, use any mechanical or electrical equipment, drink alcohol or sign any important documents for 24 hours following the sedation. We would not legally be able to accept your signature for payment after sedating you, so would ask you could settle the enclosed invoice prior to the sedation.

Again we look forward to working with you to secure a successful aesthetic Implant.
